

** The video and posters should comply with guidelines of Govt. of India (MoH, Ayush etc.)

Desired requirements for Video and Poster:

Poster making competition

1. Can be handmade/ digital
2. Any written information shall be in Regional language
3. Size_ A4
4. Theme: one or more themes can be incorporated (related to COVID-19 only)

Video making competition

1. Not more than 2 minutes duration
2. Size : 15 MB
3. Format : MP4
4. Can be Self shoot/ Animated
5. Shall be in regional language/dialect along with English subtitles

Guidelines for Participants:

- One entry is permitted from Single participants,
- Participants can send their entries in a Group/team (not more than 5 members),
- Participants are advised to send their entries through their Institutions,
- Poster and Video should be on the suggested themes,
- Participants need to share his/her consent for UBA rights on usage of the Entries received,
- Participants need to share his/her account details verified by Institute,(Need to upload on google drive and the sharable link is to be submitted on the registration form)
- Last date to register: 18th June 2021 (11:59pm)

- RCIs are suggested to design and plan their evaluation process by their own,
- RCIs are suggested to mobilize Jury members from diverse background and outside the campus.
- Regional Result announcement shall be done by RCI (1st, 2nd, 3rd Prize in both the categories) by 25th June 2021 in both categories
- RCIs shall communicate top 2 entries to NCI, for the next round for National Award by 24th June 2021.
- RCIs are allowed to use contingency fund to draw Rs. 26500 for award money (1st/2nd/3rd prize in Video category Rs. 10000/6000/2500 respectively and Rs.8,000 for poster category (1st -Rs. 4000/2nd -2500/3rd - 1500)


Report:
