
**Objective:**

World Environment Day is the biggest international day for the environment. It is celebrated every year on 5th June. Its main objective is to protect and nurture our environment to achieve the sustainable development of the world.

**Report:**

World Environment Day is the United Nations' principal vehicle for encouraging worldwide awareness and action for protection of the environment. It has evolved into the biggest global platform for environmental outreach under the direction of the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and is held every year since 1972. Millions of people all over the world celebrate it. ITS Engineering College celebrated World Environment Day in the campus on Monday, June 5th, 2023. This year, the theme of World Environment Day is "Beat the Plastic Pollution". It focuses on the solutions to plastic pollution. It is a reminder that people's actions on plastic pollution matters. The world is being inundated by plastic. More than 400 million tons of plastic is produced every year, half of which is designed to be used only once. Of that, less than 10 per cent is recycled. An estimated 19-23 million tons ends up in lakes, rivers and seas annually. Discarded or burnt single-use plastic has detrimental effect on human health and biodiversity and pollutes every ecosystem from mountain tops to the ocean floors. It became the major contributor of climate change, biodiversity loss and pollution.

Reflecting the Indian philosophy and lifestyle of co-existence with nature, I.T.S Engineering College – a premier technical institute in Greater Noida has also contributed in a small way to celebrate. The event was coordinated by Dr. Megha Saxena. The purpose of organizing World Environment Day was to raise awareness on environmental problems and to call for collaborative action to keep the

  
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environment clean and safe. Hundreds of I. T. S students join this drive and planted saplings in the college premises as well as at their homes in high rise societies.

After the activity was over, a series of informative talk by some noteworthy speakers was given. Dr. Mayank Garg, Director I.T.S Engineering College urged everyone to come together in fighting the global menace of plastic pollution and its adverse effect on environment and biodiversity. He emphasized on the exploration of sustainable alternatives to reduce the production and excessive use of single-use plastic which pollutes our oceans, damages marine life and threatens human health. He spoke about various methods to reduce plastic pollution like, use of natural fibre bags like jute bags or paper bags, buy goods in bulk, recycle the reused plastic materials such as bottles, toys etc. He also encouraged students to give some technical solution to get rid-off plastic waste. In his speech, he also notified the rapidly changing climate resulted from global warming and high pollution which is adversely affecting all living beings. He said that the only way to reduce global warming is to plant more diverse trees which will help in decreasing pollution level and will restore the biodiversity of our ecosystem.

Dr. O.P. Chaudhary, Head, Department of Applied Sciences and Humanities, also acquainted students with the current condition of environment and encourage them to participate in making our environment clean and safe. He said “the harmful effects of plastic waste on living organisms, economy and environment cannot be ignored”. He emphasized on 3R policy i.e., reduce, reduce and recycle. At last, all students, faculty members and dignitaries took the oath to reduce the use of plastic materials in future.







8. Mr.Arun Rana suggested the four names for Lucknow AICTE IIC meeting and two names to attend Mentor Institute activity in the month of August ,2022.






**C. Outcome of the activity:**


**C. Outcome of the activity:**

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Institution , Dadri, G. Noida. Following points were discussed during the meeting:

1. Initially the team comprising IIC officers & members of mentee (VGI) given their presentation before the Mentor Organization- ITS College, G. Noida on different set of activity conducted during the period of Q3 & Q4.
2. The role and responsibility of IIC was briefed and importance of innovation was highlighted by the mentor- Dr. Rajiv Ranjan of Mentor Organization. The launch of New Education Policy 2020 which completed two years of its journey and its importance to create value addition in the core curriculum was highlighted.
3. The Ministry of Education schemes were discussed in sync with Govt Mission to promote start ups and entrepreneurship skills.
4. It was suggested by the Mentor organization to set-up NISP- National Innovation & Start-up Policy at Institute level with a specific budget to promote innovative ideas amongst students.
5. An ecosystem at institute level to be developed for promoting innovative ideas to practical Shape. For this a separate committee of faculties and students to be formed for receiving ideas, its recognition, evaluation, suggestion and afterwards rewards/incentive to be given to students.
6. It was suggested that Mentee( VGI) further add five institutions( schools & colleges) to develop and promote the innovative skills, ideas and its importance to make India self reliant.
- 7 . It was also suggested by the mentor organization not to make changes amongst officers of IIC In case of unavoidable circumstances, new team member can be added.
8. It was suggested by the mentor organization to invite industry people as external member to participate in review meeting. Preference should be given to those whom have developed its own set up.
9. A link of IIC- MoE to be added in website of mentee organization where all the activities to be uploaded.
10. To encourage participation of maximum students to come forward with their innovative ideas' it has been decided to organize zonal level competition.
11. It has been suggested by the mentor institute to join 15 hours innovation Ambassador Program.

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12. It has been suggested by the mentor organization to take part in 29th August 22, meeting of AKTU Lucknow . Four member team to be formed from officers of IIC to show case their achievement in different vertical. A size of 6" 4" stall shall be provided during exhibition..

13. After meeting Dr. Rajiv Ranjan , mentor of organization visited workshop, where student from computer Sc, Mechanical, Electrical, Pharma, Agriculture shown their current projects.
